1. V1 _____She was a deacon in the church, in the same category as the 7 men appointed in Acts 6:1-6. • There has always been some discussion about the place of women leaders in the church. Psalm 68:11 Paul says in I Timothy 2:12, "I do not let women teach men or have authority over them." Also, the deacon requirements of I Timothy 3:12 do not seem to fit a woman. However, it is obvious from Scripture that women were in leadership positions in the early church. For example, Priscilla is mentioned in this chapter before Aquila, her husband, indicating that she was probably the one most gifted with ministry. Also Lydia in Philippi -- the church met in her home. She was the home group pastor. Acts 16:14-40 • The Vineyard has decided that each congregation can decide if they want to ordain women as pastors or not.

2. V3 _____Paul shows us how to greet and treat each other in the church and in the world as well. He remembers each person by name and has something true and edifying to say about each one. Edification and affection create relationships, which make it much easier to deal with the truths, disagreements and such of our life together. Their names are written in heaven. Luke 10:20

3. V5 _____The early community of Christians did not have church buildings to meet in. That came hundreds of years later for two reasons: (1) The small group in the homes allowed people to be family to each other and give each one a chance to share, to prophecy, to share wisdom and knowledge, to pray for the sick and such. (2) The church was persecuted for the first 300 years of its existence. The Christians needed to have hidden places to worship. Vineyards all have Kinships, where small groups of brethren meet in the homes. Commonly there were many of these small churches in homes. Galatians 1:2

4. V7, V11, V21 _____ Paul had relatives in the church at Rome and relatives who traveled with him. The most natural way for the church to grow is that people who have been transformed by Jesus draw their friends and relatives, co-workers and neighbors into the kingdom of God.

5. V17 _____ Every church has to come to the place of maturity where its leaders and people recognize wolves who come to eat the sheep. (Acts 20:29) Then they should refuse to empower them to speak or lead.

6. V20 _____We are not contending with flesh and blood but with evil spirits who work on all people -- especially Christians. Ephesians 6:10f. They come to steal, kill and destroy by deception, depression, temptation and oppression, stirring up fear, anger and pride. Jesus is the only one who is wiser and stronger than the devil and his servants. "He who is in you is greater than he (Satan) who is in the world." I John 4:4 We say, "Jesus, You compel every spirit that is not subject to You to leave."
